Proposed Language: (changes in red)

4.3 - Term of Office:

Each Senator shall serve a two-year term commencing on June 1 of the year in which elected, except for the two Part-Time Faculty Senators, who shall serve a one-year term commencing on June 1 of the year in which elected.

Terms of office for two year terms shall be staggered so that each year only half of the Senate positions shall be open for election.

Senators can only serve two consecutive terms or a total of four consecutive years, whichever is greater.

The Senate body discussed what happens in various situations where faculty resign, their contract is not renewed, a senator is removed, can senators serve non-consecutive term limits, and whether or not the senator has to resign in these situations. It was noted this bylaw change is being made to create equity for part-time faculty while building on what already exists. This item will come to the Senate in November for a second read and vote.
